TRAINING SCHEDULE: July 1-September 30, 2021

Please let us know if you are planning to attend. It is imperative that you pre-register for all classes you want to attend. Failure to do so may result in the class being cancelled for low enrollment, failure of the instructor to bring enough materials for all students who arrive, or refusal to allow you to attend the class in situations where enrollment is limited. If you are signed up for a class, please notify the Academy within 24 hours before the class that you will not be unable to attend. This may give someone else an opportunity to take your place.

All training will be held at the LSO Training Academy at 712 Broadway at no charge, unless otherwise specified.

Training Mandates & Certificates

There are two 24-month periods in the current training cycle which ends on August 31, 2021. The first 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2017 and ends on 08/31/2019. The second 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2019 and ends on 08/31/2021, which is also the conclusion date of the 48-month training cycle.

New Cycle begins there are two 24-month periods in the current training cycle which ends on August 31, 2025. The first 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2021 and ends on 08/31/2023. The second 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2023 and ends on 08/31/2025, which is also the conclusion date of the 48-month training cycle.

Course Topics: This class will focus on the basic understanding of S.W.A.T. operations, including: Team organization and structure, case study and liability, marksmanship responsibilities, entries, warrant and tactical planning, introduction to breaching, firearms, chemical agents, less-lethal options. This class will be hands on and will require physical exertion and many hours of practical exercises at various venues in and around the Lubbock area.

Prerequisites:

A physical assessment will be completed prior to the start of the course. Each student must meet standard based on a point system. (Push-ups, Sit-ups, 1 mile run, and Pull-ups)

A pistol and rifle qualification will be conducted prior to the start of the course. Each student must meet standards. Please complete your weapon zero before the start of the class. We will use a 50 yard zero. This course is open to current Law Enforcement Agencies, Federal Law Enforcement Agencies, and active duty military personnel only. ID's will be confirmed.

Flash light mounted on pistol and rifle.
